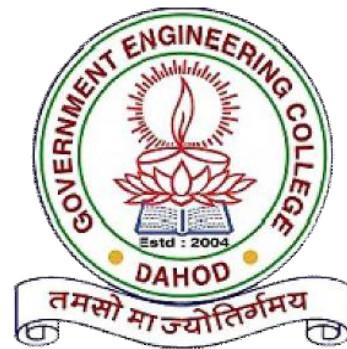




Report on Plantation Drive

On July 14, 2026, the National Service Scheme (NSS) unit of Government Engineering College, Dahod, organized a campus-wide Tree Plantation Drive aimed at promoting environmental sustainability and fostering social responsibility among newly enrolled students. To kick off the initiative, first-year NSS volunteers and faculty members gathered for an introductory briefing covering proper sapling planting techniques and long-term care instructions. Working collaboratively across designated areas of the campus, volunteers led the physical efforts of preparing the soil and planting, while faculty members participated alongside them to provide guidance and support. Through their joint efforts, a total of 50 saplings were successfully planted, expanding the campus's green cover and contributing to local soil conservation and biodiversity. Beyond its environmental impact, the drive served as a valuable platform for student-faculty engagement outside the traditional classroom setting, giving first-year volunteers practical exposure to community service and teamwork. The event concluded with a vote of thanks to all participants, with the NSS unit committing to the ongoing maintenance of the saplings to ensure their growth and long-term survival.
